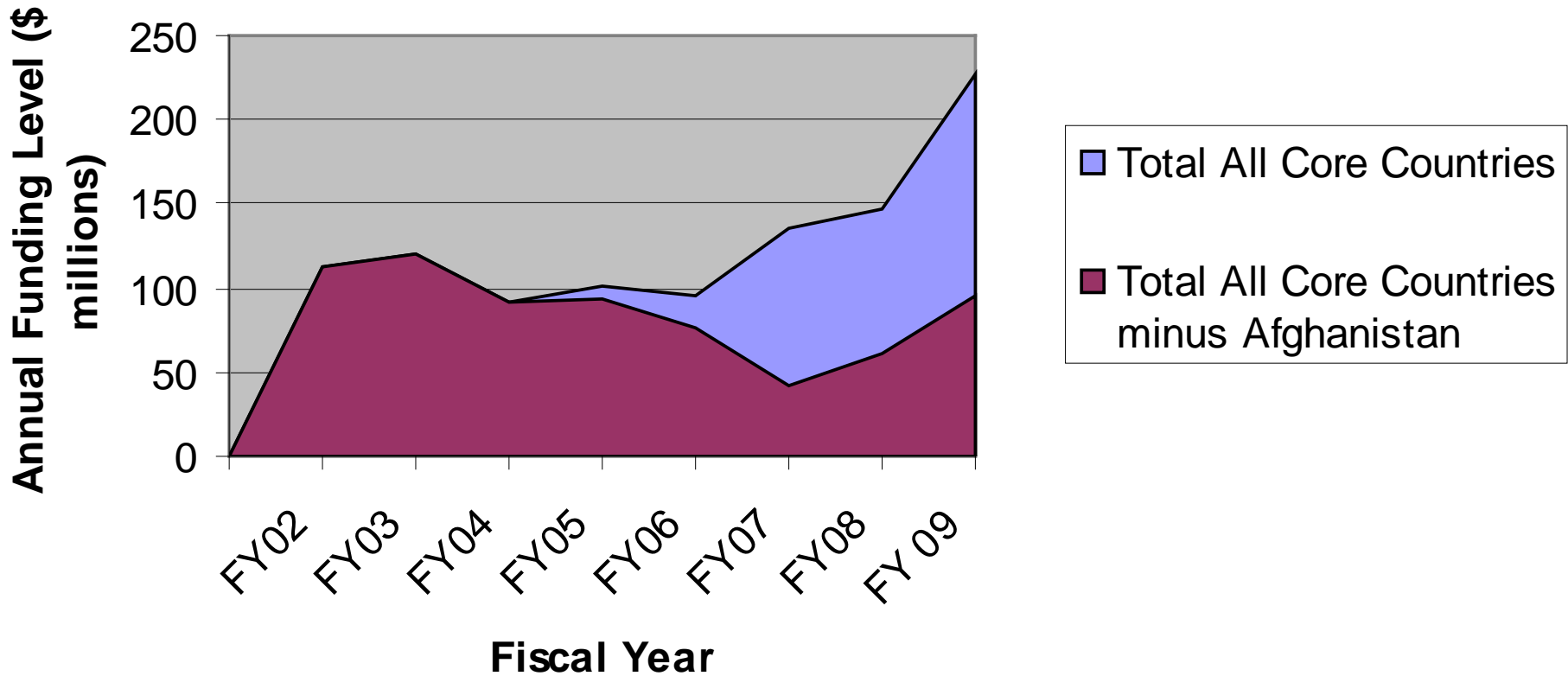

USAID Energy Program Objectives

- Clean energy: technologies, systems and practices that significantly reduce carbon emissions associated with energy use over the long-term
- Energy sector reforms and improved energy sector governance
- Energy security
- Expanded access to energy services for economic growth and poverty reduction
- Energy sector rehabilitation in conflict and post-conflict situations
- Regional energy trade and cooperation

EXCLUDING AFGHANISTAN, USAID'S ENERGY PROGRAM HAS DECLINED IN PAST 8 YEARS. BUT CLEAN ENERGY FUNDING IS \$108.5 MILLION IN FY 2010, AND \$128 MILLION IS EXPECTED IN FY 2011.
